S.R.O. 182 In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso of article 309 of the Constitution, and in super session of the Indian Ordnance Factories Group Co, Supervisory and Non-Gazetted Cadre (Recruitment and conditions of service) Rules, 1989 in so far as they relate to the posts of Foreman(Tech), except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following Rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Junior Works Manager in the Ordnance Factories Organisation, namely:-

- 1. Short title and commencement-
 - These Rules may be called the Indian Ordnance Factories Organisations, Junior Works Manager (Group �B� post) Recruitment Rules, 1996.
 - (ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.
- 2. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay The number of the said posts, their classification and the scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
- 3. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualification The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said schedule.
- 4. Disqualification :- No person �
 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
 - (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person, shall be eligible for appointment to any of the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the Personal Law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of these Rule.

- 5. Power to relax: Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary of expedient so to do, it may, by order, and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- 6. Saving: Nothing in these Rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Schedule Caste, Scheduled Tribes, Ex-Servicemen, other special categories of persons in accordance with the Orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
